BRIEF

To design the interior of a new luxury hotel on Camps Bay beachfront designed by Scott+Partners. The designs must include the hotel reception and lobby, two different bedroom designs, the beach bar, and the branding of the hotel including its name and brand. Also include designs for the spa and the hotel terrace and pool area.

The design must be relevant for a 5* luxury beachfront resort, and be upmarket and on trend with an international feel. The clear concept must be a consistent thread and run throughout the hotel.

CONCEPT THE ODYSSEY


The design for this hotel is a tribute to the rich and varied history of not only Camps Bay but also to the people and the extraordinary animals who, over the centuries, have made it their home. This led to the name - The Odyssey - which translated from its Greek origin means 'a long journey full of hardship and adventure", and this is what many endured to get here. The Dutch sailors made the long and hazardous journey down the coast of West Africa in the 1600's, and later brought slaves here, dragged from their home in Benin. Many others followed, all led by the stars of the Southern skies. Today, tourists make the journey here, and all of these people have brought a little of their culture with them.

But others still make the same long and exhausting journey here that they have been making for thousands of years. These are the migrating birds that travel without fail all the way to our shores from Europe, and the whales who frequent the shores to come and have their young before heading back home to then make that journey all over again.


The design of The Odyssey takes its visitors on this journey and then gives them a safe haven in which to rest, rejuvenate, and enjoy in luxurious surroundings until it's time for them to continue on.

Drawing on the simplicity of Dutch-inspired interiors along with the bronze and wood synonymous with Benin, the Odyssey is at the same time very modern with a constrained colour palette. It is African but without any of the cliches. Sink into soft, plush furnishings, soak and unwind in deep copper baths or in the cocoon of the spa. On your way to either the glamorous pool or to the fun of the beach bar, walk through the lobby and underneath the flock of birds that are a constant reminder of all those journeys that led to this beautiful place.









BRIEF

To reuse and adapt the Collier Jetty at The V&A Waterfront. Create a journey along the jetty considering it's historical significance. This must include a fish market to reignite the industry, restaurants and a bar, and an exhibition/installation space to showcase local design talent.


CONCEPT AMANZI

In the heart of the Waterfront is Collier Jetty, long idle and forgotten but about to be reborn with new life. Seemingly rising up from the infinite ocean beyond, I imagine a shimmering, wave-like structure enveloping the space and giving the sense that the old has been washed away, immersing visitors in a bright, clean and rejuvenated space. The combination of the fish market, casual and also fine dining, along with an immersive live art exhibition space will all reference back to the movement of the ocean, conjuring the life it contains and the power of its continual ebb and flow, mimmicked by the life now contained within this new structure. It will draw people in and encourage a sense of freedom and excitement.



BRIEF

To design the Strand Street Quarry node for the Heritage Route. The brief is to take a disregarded quarry overtaken by litter and vagrants and to create a hub that will attract visitors and make them want to use it as the location from which to explore the tourist attractions of Cape Town via the Lion Battery Cable Car and other public transport.

It must include a ticket office, retail space, and restaurant for 50, incorporating COVID restrictions. It must be exciting, an experience, and visually interesting.

CONCEPT The Protea Pavilion



On the slope of the mountain just above Sea Point, is the home of a new tourism hub for Cape Town comprising of an information and learning centre, exhibition space, restaurant, retail space, and ticket office for the cable cars and bus links to the city's tourist destinations.

The hub consists of a cluster of three exciting buildings inspired by our national flower, the Protea, with petal shapes encompassing the pods and giving visual appeal. The petals will be lit at night to glow ethereally in the landscape, while the cable cars and buses can be construed as pollinating seeds being blown across the mountain and down to the coast. These buildings will attract tourists and engage with them, being the embodiment of all the history and natural beauty of this city.




BRIEF

CONCEPT | QUEST-CE QUE CEST?






Also importantly, there needed to be access and a connection to both the roof garden and the atrium, an outdoor area on the 9th floor.

CONCEPT The Matchbox




The bathroom stuns with a wall mural of Bisazza tiles, Agape shower systems and a pink quartz sink.




CONCEPT | TINE TUNED



BRIEF

This is your first SketchUp project. Your two young entrepreneurial clients have noticed a gap in the market with the imminent approach of level 4 Covid restrictions for an order in/takeaway restaurant. Using their two recently purchased shipping containers, design a young, fresh and vibrant space as well as choosing the theme and menu. 
CONCEPT U.ORDER

U.ORDER is a modern fish and chip restaurant situated on Collier Jetty at Cape Town's waterfront. The two containers have been placed in an offset parallel design, one used as the restaurant and the other as the kitchen and order area.


Externally the building is stunning, covered in metal fish scales, with both containers linked together by dramatic corten steel sun shades, two of these being used as areas for parking of delivery vehicles.

Internally, an acid washed concrete floor is eyecatching but also easy to clean. The outside scales are repeated on the walls, and the container doors have been modified with large glass panels to allow easy access between inside and out.








CONCEPT | 16 MURRAY

Rose Murray is an internationally recognised interior designer, her piece de resistance being Hide, a Michelin star restaurant in London's Green Park. I used this restaurant as inspiration for her apartment located at 16 Fulham Road, Bakoven, because it includes all the things she loves, such as organic shapes and materials, natural products, including wood and clay that celebrate our connection to nature, and a neutral and soothing palette. I wanted to give her an apartment that was a luxurious and comfortable space, but with a simplicity that would enable her to rlax as soo as she walked in the door after one of her many work trips overseas. For this reason it also needed to be easy to maintain, almost a lock up and go. With the ocean views, sunsets and tranquility of Bakoven I though this would be the perfect spot.





BRIFF

The Constitutional Court, the guardian of The Constitution, has eleven chairs for the eleven judges who uphold and defend the South African Constitution. Design a 12th chair to represent the people's seat of power as Guardians of Constitution, to express their values and from which they can speak boldly to those in power.

The design must give a feeling of comfort and empowerment, regardless or race, class, gender, sexual orientation, culture, ethnicity or age who uphold the values of the Constitution. Think about it being the seat from which the People can speak boldly to those it power.

CONCEPT THE PROTECTOR


What could be a more iconic symbol for the design of a chair to represent the people of South Africa than the Baobab tree? Growing and living in some of the harshest environments of our country, this tree is a reflection of the strength and resilience of all our citizens, our ability to have weathered a turbulent history, and the power to go forward as one with a voice that will be heard.

Known as The Tree of Life, The Baobab can live to over a thousand years old, provides shelter within its huge trunk, and is a source of food, clothing, and water for both humans and animals alike. It's bark is fire-resistant, and the tree conditions the surrounding soil, filling it with nutrients and helping avoid erosion.

The tree is a metaphor to show not only the power of our voice but also our guardianship of our own land. Translating this into a chair, I have chosen the solidity and natural nature of wood. It is constructed of fourteen layers to represent the diversity and many stratas of the whole nation. The seat envelops you while the branches rise above, giving a sense of security and protection. It's nature is very organic but it has a vital presence which will make the person who occupies it have a feeling of empowerment and able to take their true place at the Constitutional Court.

BRIEF

Design a free-standing drinks cabinet which must include a bar fridge or wine cooler, either concealed or exposed, and drawers for storage of smaller items. There must be storage for alcohol and glasses, and an area for pouring drinks and holding ice buckets etc., as well as space for a small dustbin. 2500mm x 700mm is the maximum footprint of the unit with a maximum height of 2400mm and a minimum height of 900 mm.


CONCEPT The Vault

My vision for this drinks cabinet was to give it the look of a safe and so I called it The Vault. It has an industrial feel but at the same time it is still very luxe due to the materials used. The main body of the cabinet is made of brass, with the wine fridge built in, whereas the bottles and glasses are displayed on glass shelves above to give sparkle and lightness. 

Inspired by the map of world-wide flight paths, this design has a light airy feeling, and the colour is reminiscent of the sky.









This is a complex geometric pattern in black and white, creating an almost optical illusion. At the same time, it is quite sophisticated and could be used for multiple applications.








