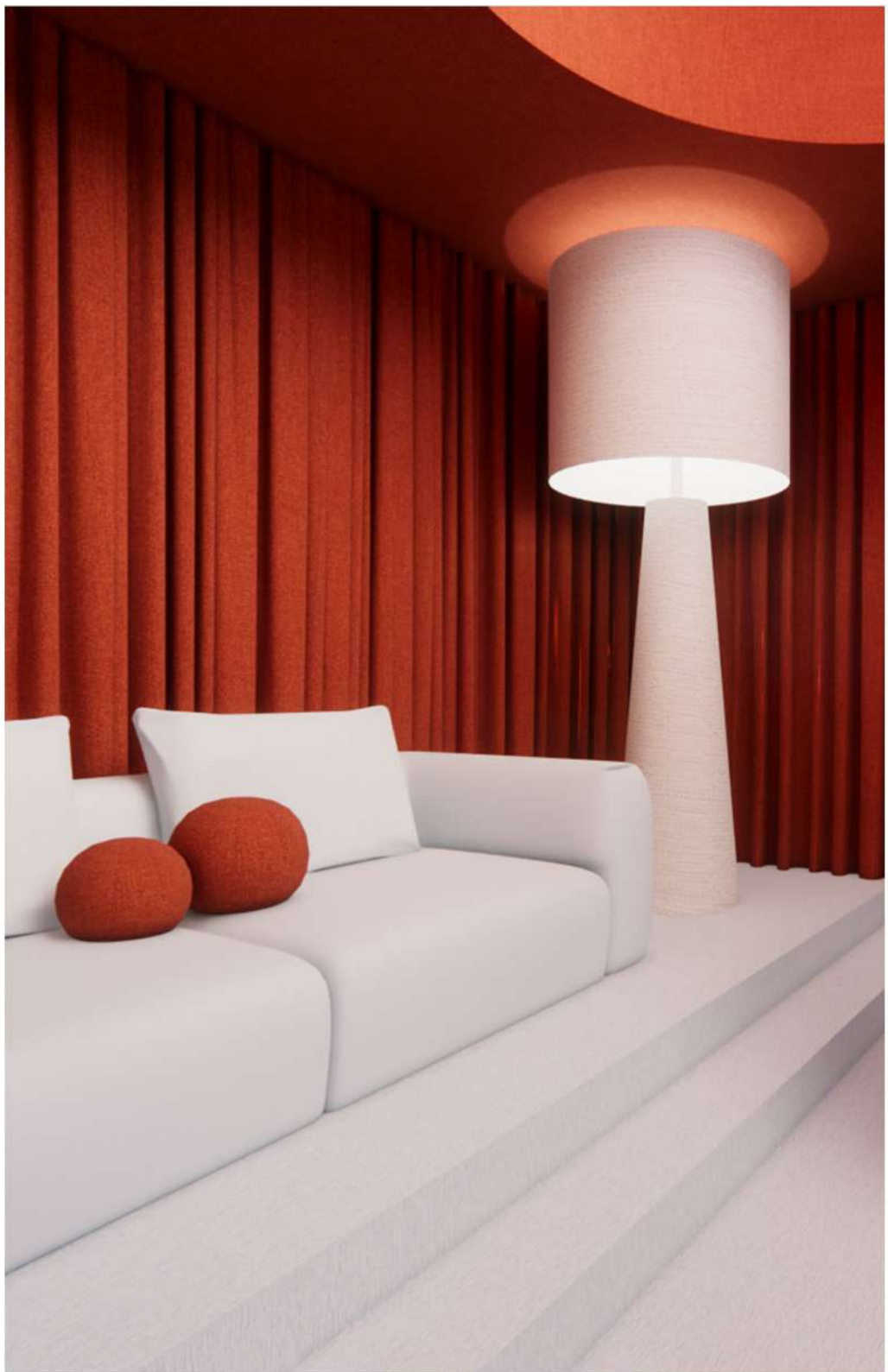


MAIN LAPPA FLOOR PLAN / NTS





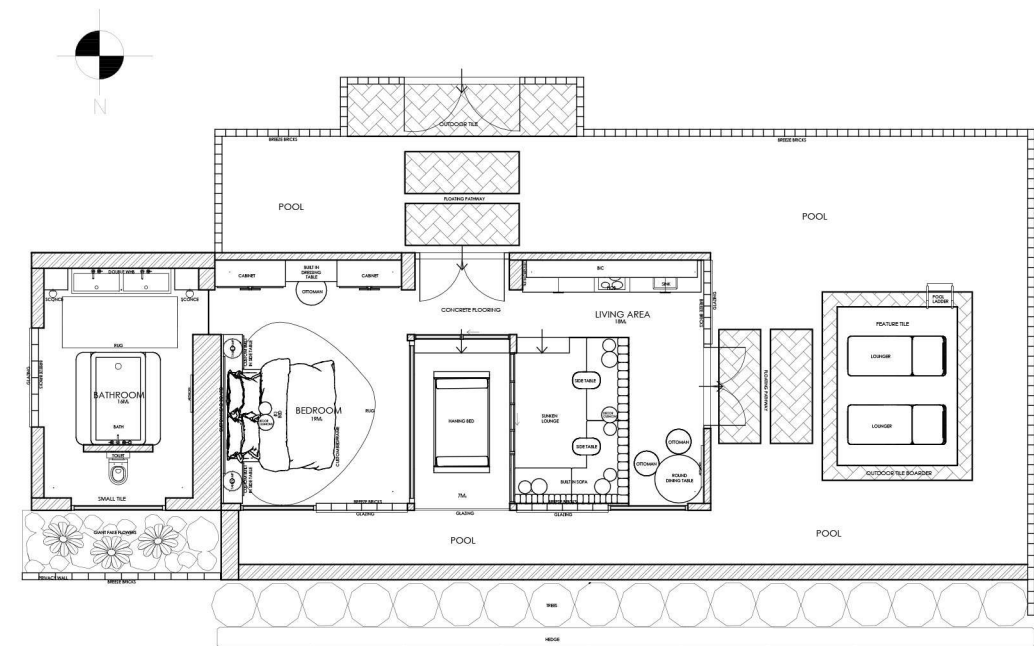
