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






CONCEPT

For my project, I drew inspiration from the captivating elements of nature, particularly focusing on the concept of the Tankwa, known as the "thirst land." Considering the region's water scarcity, l integrated an indoor pool to conserve this precious resource and minimize condensation. To deepen the connection with nature, I incorporated expansive windows

merizing night sky and promoting natural airflow within the building. To encapsulate the area's inherent uncertainties, I elegantly integrated organic shapes into the design. The building's facade, adorned with natural hues and utilizing the earth-like structure, perfectly mirrors the sand dunes of the Tankwa Karoo, establishing a harmonious integra-tion with the surrounding land. Inspired by the fundamental elements, I artistically incorporated the earth itself as a significant design element, while fire finds its place through a cozy fire pit and braai area.


Boxwood Lift and Lobby Floor Plan NTS
